Ollie's Cape Scooter Garment
designed by Pam

Materials:

Rip stop nylon (light to medium weight) rectangle 23" x 23"

Fleece rectangle 19" x 19"

Waterproof pillow cover or mattress pad rectangle 19" x 19"

1 package 3/4-1" wide non-roll woven elastic (36 inches, cut in half into two 18" pieces)

2 Fashion-Fit clips - from the sewing notions aisle Thread

- Layer ripstop nylon on bottom and center the waterproof material over that with the fleece on top of the waterproof barrier, making it a 3 layer stack of fabric. Fig. 1
- 2. Fold each edge of ripstop over twice, until the ripstop wraps over the other two fabrics evenly making a clean seam around the edge. *Fig* 2
- 3. Sew on the double fold all around the cape.
- 4. Attach each 18" length of elastic, crossing about 2 inches from where it attaches to the cape in the front and back. Sew at elastic crosses. Front and back views of the garment straps are the same.
- 5. Use Fashion-Fit Clips on the chest side and back side to keep the straps from slipping down over the shoulders. This size is for a standard doxie, sizes may have to be adjusted to your dog. Hope this helps!
